





I have received the same answer from all sources that I have attempted to obtain information from about my husband. All the information which the War Department has given me isthat my husband radioed he was going to crash land approximately ten miles west of the Rhine. That information was received last May after my husband and crew went down on March 24, 1945.

Four of my husband's crew were reported definetly identified three were found with those four but were not identified. The other two still listed as missing until Jan. 15, 1946 when my husband was reported K.I.A.

We have learned through friends that the seven boys found are buried in Margraten, Holland.

I want to know the following questions and I hope you will obtain the answers for me. I think it only fair that the one's who lost loved one's overseas know the circumstances of that persons death and where he is burried.

- 1. Was my husband identified and if so how?
- 2. If he was found with the other boys who were found with the plane soon after his crash, why wasn't he identified then?
- 3. There is my husband buried?
- 4. Did the plane burn?

He was dropping supplies accrossthe Rhine at Wesel, Germany at the time of his death.
