The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final buriel of the horses dead of World Wer II. The Quartermenter General of the Army has been entructed with this secred responsibility to the honored dead. Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinchip, please complete Pert II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Pert III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Descine" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed exvelope, which requires no pactage; within 30 days after its receipt by your Its prompt return will evoid winecessary delays.
