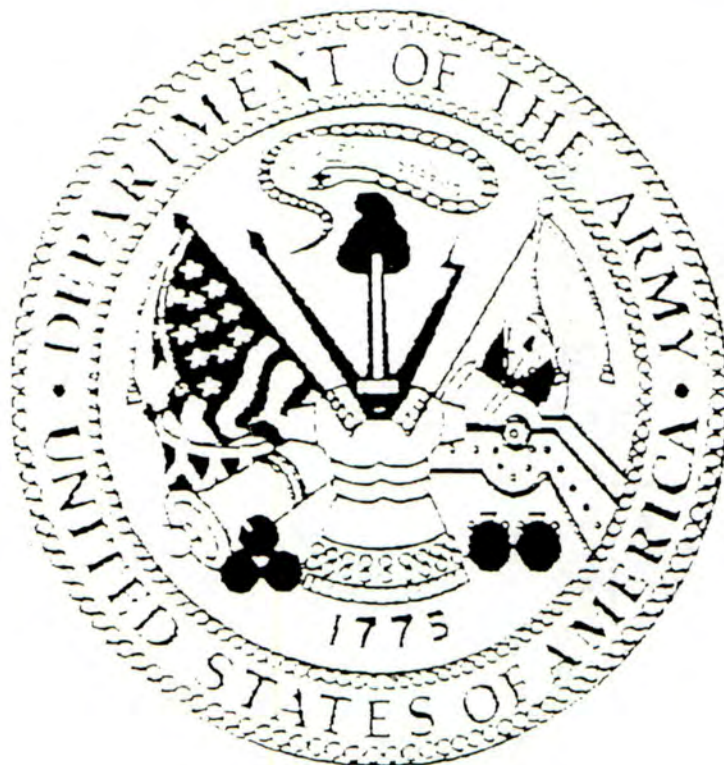

1. The Board convened pursuant to par. 4, SO No. 32, Headquarters, 7887 Graves Registration Detachment, APO 757, US Army, 10 April 1951, at Liege, Belgium, on 12 April 1951.

2. Members present:

3. PURPOSE: To review and determine, from evidence presented, the non-recoverability of the remains of the deceased in question, lost in the geographical area as described below:

a. Vicinity of Wesel (K-52/A-24) Germany. Case #12341.

b. Facts:

The casualties listed below were three of five crew members of aircraft C-47-A-DK (cargo), which failed to return from a glider tow mission to Yalta (Wesel) Germany, on 24 March 1945.

4. FINDINGS:

a. From witnesses statements it is revealed that aircraft was hit by flak approximately 4 miles north east of Wesel, and crashed in the area. Two of the crew parachuted, were held as prisoners, but were later rescued by paratroopers.

b. Sweeping Operations have been conducted in the area concerned, however, of the unknowns recovered, none may be associated with the subject casualties.
