

Facts

ON APRIL 30, 1945, the 82nd Airborne Division launched an assault across the Northern Elbe at Becklade, Germany. This was the last bridgehead of the European War and No. 11 for the 82nd. Perhaps destiny took things in hand, for two years earlier, in Sicily, on July 9, 1943, it was this same Division, the 82nd Airborne, that parachuted into the flak-riddled night hours before ground forces struck the beaches, to become the first Allied troops to land successfully on Festung Europa. Since that original D-Day in Sicily, the 82nd Sky Commandos landed from the air on Italy, Normandy and Holland, were seaborne at Anzio, and established vital bridgeheads across the Volturno,

Douve, Merderet, Maas, Waal, Rhine, and Elbe Rivers. The 82nd Airborne was the first U. S. Airborne Division overseas, the first to see combat, captured the most prisoners (200,000), made the most Airborne Invasions (4), had the most combat hours (371), made the first bridgehead in Europe (Sicily), and liberated the first town in Normandy (Ste. Mère Eglise). It was selected as the honor-Division to police Berlin after VE-Day, then received the supreme compliment by being designated as the Division to lead the American Ground Forces Parade down 5th Ave., New York, Jan. 12, 1946. British General Sir Miles Dempsey, in Holland, said of the 82nd Airborne, "—the greatest division in the world today."

We've got to eat and run.


Oh, for the gang that used to be!







LONDON, July 16 (AP)—Fifty-
two thousand illegitimate children
were born to British girls during
1944, Judge John Watson revealed
today.

The jurist cited the figure during
a broadcast appeal for funds for the
National Council for the Unmar-
ried Mother and Her Child, an
organization which promotes found-
ling homes for children and sup-
ports legislation for unwed mothers
and their offspring.

Yesterday, the London Sunday

which could be converted into
nurseries for 1,000 unwanted
babies for adoption.


