TO : Whom It May Concern.

1. T/Sgt Robert F. Allen, 32937299, has been aerial engineer of a fortress on my crew for the past eleven (11) months and on twenty-seven (27) combat missions.

2. During this period, T/Sgt Allen has maintained a superior record in every respect. His coolness and ability to work under pressure are noteworthy.

3. In spite of the frequent breakdown in the traditional barriers between officers and enlisted men under actual combat service, T/Sgt Allen has always maintained a strict observance of military courtesy.

4. As a civilian pilot, he has more than 2,000 hours, of which more than half is in planes of 225 HP or above.

5. In view of the above, it is strongly recommended that T/Sgt Allen be given an opportunity to obtain for himself a rating as pilot in the Army Air Forces.
