President Johnson has asked that I reply to your recent letter regarding your desire to have the remains of your son, the late First Lieutenant A. Earl Dorsett, returned from an oversea cemetery for reburial in this country.

Final disposition of the dead of World War II was made under the Act of 5 August 1947, 61 Stat. 779, which terminated on 31 December 1951. Under this authority the remains of those American military decedents whose next of kin desired their burial overseas were permanently interred in accordance with the expressed wishes. Subsequently all of the permanent cemeteries established on foreign soil after World War II were transferred to the jurisdiction of the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington, D. C. 20360, for beautification and maintenance as permanent memorials to the dead of that war.

After remains have been interred in a permanent American Cemetery and Memorial as requested by the next of kin, the Department of the Army has no further authority in the matter; and the Commission does not permit disinterments from the oversea cemeteries even at private expense.

Your letter pertaining to the remains of your son, the late First Lieutenant Adelbert E. Dorsett, has come to my attention.

I am sure you will understand that it was not possible to inter our deceased military personnel in caskets during the stress of combat in the area in which your son died. However, his remains were placed in a blanket or canvas shroud prior to burial. This method was used in World War I for our heroic dead and was found to be much more satisfactory than when temporary caskets were used.

The casket in which the remains of your son will be placed for final burial will be of standard size and in every way comparable to the best accepted standards of the Funeral Directors' profession.

When the remains of your son are disinterred and prepared for final burial, they will be placed in the casket in the proper manner by experienced personnel. The casket is then hermetically sealed and placed in a protective wooden case for shipment, under military escort, to that cemetery designated by the next of kin for final burial.

I can assure you that the casket will be most appropriate for our honored dead.


