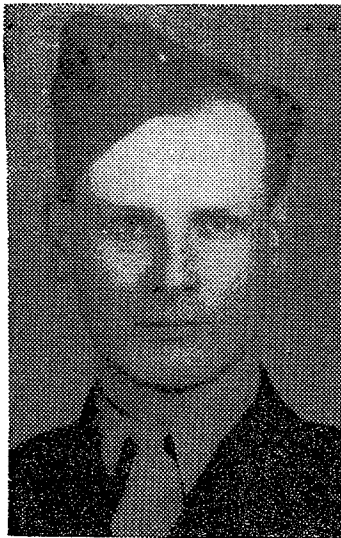


Four Fehrenbach Brothers Enter Two Branches of Armed Service

James, William Are in Marines; Don, Norman in Army Air Corps

Pfc. James J. Fehrenbach, Aviation Cadet Don N. Fehrenbach, Pvt. William C. Fehrenbach, and Norman H. Fehrenbach, four sons of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Fehrenbach, are in the armed services, Norman having passed his physical examination for immediate induction in the Army Air Corps at Milwaukee yesterday and having left last night for Fort Sheridan, Ill.

Pvt. James J. Fehrenbach, 25, who is stationed at San Diego, Calif., was graduated from the eighth grade at Sacred Heart Parochial School here and finished high school and one year of college at Maryhurst Normal, Kirkwood, Mo.

Volunteered in April

He volunteered for service in the U. S. Marine Corps April 20, 1942, and at present is with Headquarters Company Training Center, Motor Transport Fleet Marine Forces, Camp Elliott, San Diego. In his most recent letter home he stated that he has successfully passed exams for a corporal's rating.

Aviation Cadet Don N. Fehrenbach, 23, who enlisted in the Army Air Corps June 1, 1942, and was called to service Nov. 10 for pilot training, is with S. A. A. B. Squadron 72 at Santa Ana, Calif. He completed high school and four years of college at Josephinum College, Worthington, Ohio and was graduated from the eighth grade at Sacred Heart Parochial School here.

Pvt. William C. Fehrenbach, 20, of the U. S. Marine Corps, now stationed at the Aircraft Engineering School, Squadron 23, Group 2, U. S. Naval Air Station, San Diego, Calif., volunteered for service from Austin, Minn., and was called Nov. 20, 1942. He is a graduate of Sacred Heart Parochial School and Marshfield High School.

Goes to Carleton

Norman H. (Nig) Fehrenbach, 18, was accepted Jan. 21, 1943, for a pre-meteorological course at Carleton College, Northfield, Minn., and after passing the physical yesterday, left immediately for Fort Sheridan. He was graduated from the local high school and the eighth grade at Sacred Heart.

The three other Fehrenbach children are Miss Mary Jane, 22, who is employed in the office of the Wisconsin Axle Company at Oshkosh; Robert, 16, a junior in Marshfield High School; and Joan, 13, a seventh grade pupil at Sacred Heart. Norman, William, and Robert Fehrenbach all are former News-Herald carrier boys.
