XII-BATTLE HONORS. \* \* \* \* 2. As suthorized by Executive Order No. 9396 (sec I, Bull. 22, WD, 1943) superseding Executive Order No. 9075 (sec. III, Bull. 11, WD, 1942), the following unit is cited by the Wer Department under the provisions of Section IV, Circular No. 333, War Department, 1943, in the name of the President of the United States as public evidence of deserved honor and distinction:

The 3d Bosbardsent Division (H) (then the 4th Bosbardsent Wing (H)) is cited for cutstanding performance of duty in action against the enemy on 17 August 1943. This unprecedented attack against one of Germany's most important sireraft factories was the first shuttle mission performed in this theater of operations and entailed the longest flight over strongly defended enemy territory yet accomplished at that date. For Ag hours the formation was subjected to persistent, savage assaults by large forces of enemy fighters. During this bitterly contested serial battle 150 German fighter sircraft was definitely destroyed and many more damaged. Despite desperate attempts by the enemy to scatter the bonders the groups of the 3d Bombardment Division (H) maintained a tight, defensive formation and, coordinating as a perfectly balanced team, fought their way to the assigned target at Regensburg. Though weary after hours of gruelling combat the bombardiers released their bombs accurately on the target and wrought wast destruction on an aircraft factory of vital importance to the energy's war effort. The high degree of success achieved is directly attributable to the extraordinary heroism, skill, and devotion to duty displayed by members of this unit. Their actions on this occasion uphold the highest traditions of the Armad Forces of the United States.
