8 June 1944

on 5 June 1954. I was leading ploral yellow Flight. we attacked a secondary target and ploral white Flight attacked the primary target. When we pulled off the target. I sighted whiteFlight and rejoined them above the overcast. <u>ploral WHITE</u> two reported that he had been hit by flak so ploral white Leader and ploral white Three stayed with him. I had ploral yellow three with me only, and we climbed We about 6,000 feet above white Flight. Floral Leader instructed me to get emergency fixes from control and Floral yellow three turned on his emergency INF I obtained mamercus fixes from Kangaley.

Floral white Two bailed out and white Flight circled him until he disappeared into the overcast and then returned to base because they were low on gasoline. Floral Tellow one and Three circled what we estimated as the spot last sighted above the overcast.

we had thought ploral white Two was over the Channel, but control now informs us he was still over the continent.
